Our target is 27,000 youth 3 interns at \$8.56 an hour for about 30 hours a week and 4 5 interns and employers are supported with coaches. Trust leverages over \$2.00 for every \$1.00 invested by 6 7 South Florida Work Force Investment Board, Miami-Dade County, Royal Caribbean Cruises, and there are in-kind 8 9 services being brought into this by South Florida Educational Credit Union. 10 11 Any discussion, comments, Committee members? 12 MR. HAJ: Madam Chair, if I may. The last tab, 13 there's three tabs on your agenda, the last tab is a 14 highlight report of the last year summer internship. 15 MS.
